EU4Environment Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production (RECP) project

The “European Union for Environment” (EU4Environment) aims to help the six partner countries: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Republic of Moldova, Ukraine preserve their natural capital and increase people's environmental well-being, by supporting environment-related action, demonstrating and unlocking opportunities for greener growth, and setting mechanisms to better manage environmental risks and impacts. RECP is the continuous application of prevention environmental strategies to processes, products, and services to increase efficiency and reduce risks to people and the environment. In Armenia, the RECP Demonstration Project consisted of (1) training of RECP experts, (2) coaching of demonstration companies, and (3) facilitating RECP Clubs of Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises (SMEs) located in various regions. Selected companies received support in developing business plans to invest in selected RECP measures through own or borrowed financing.



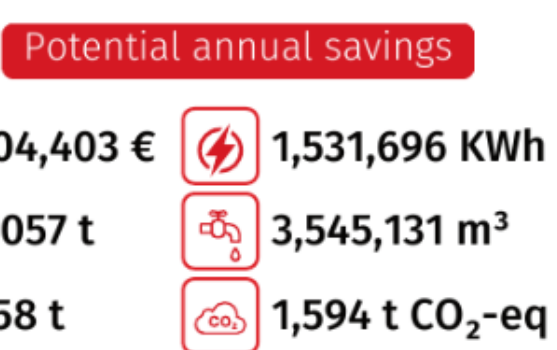
THE IMPACT

- Delivered RECP capacity building and demonstration programs to professionals and entrepreneurs, and technical assistance to industries in the adoption of RECP measures, promoting transition to Circular Economy.
- Promoted RECP implementation and scaling up among SMEs through extending capacity on RECP among experts and RECP demonstration audits in selected manufacturing enterprises.
- Raised knowledge and awareness on RECP
- Supported national capacities on RECP through provision of technical data, exchange of information and knowledge on circular economy, sustainable consumption and production, resource efficiency and cleaner production,
- Promoted RECP and Circular Economy policies and practice application based on best international and national practices.

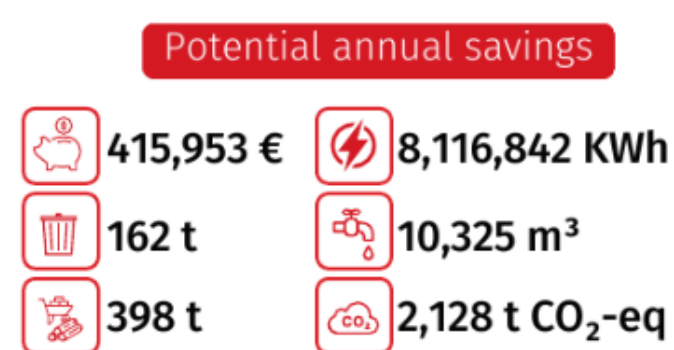

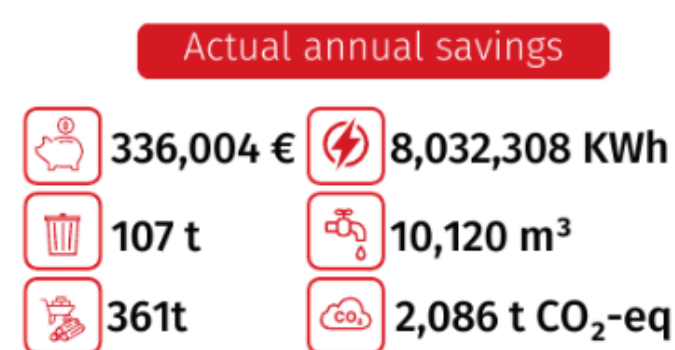
76 RECP OPTIONS IDENTIFIED FOR RECP CLUBS AND DEMONSTRATION COMPANIES
